"This new gigabit private link will allow those groups direct high speed access to MHHS computer systems, thereby bypassing the slower VPN. The images load very quickly, giving the Doctors the feeling of being at the actual hospital. By reducing the time it takes to download the study, they can be read in a shorter period of time, increasing efficiency."
